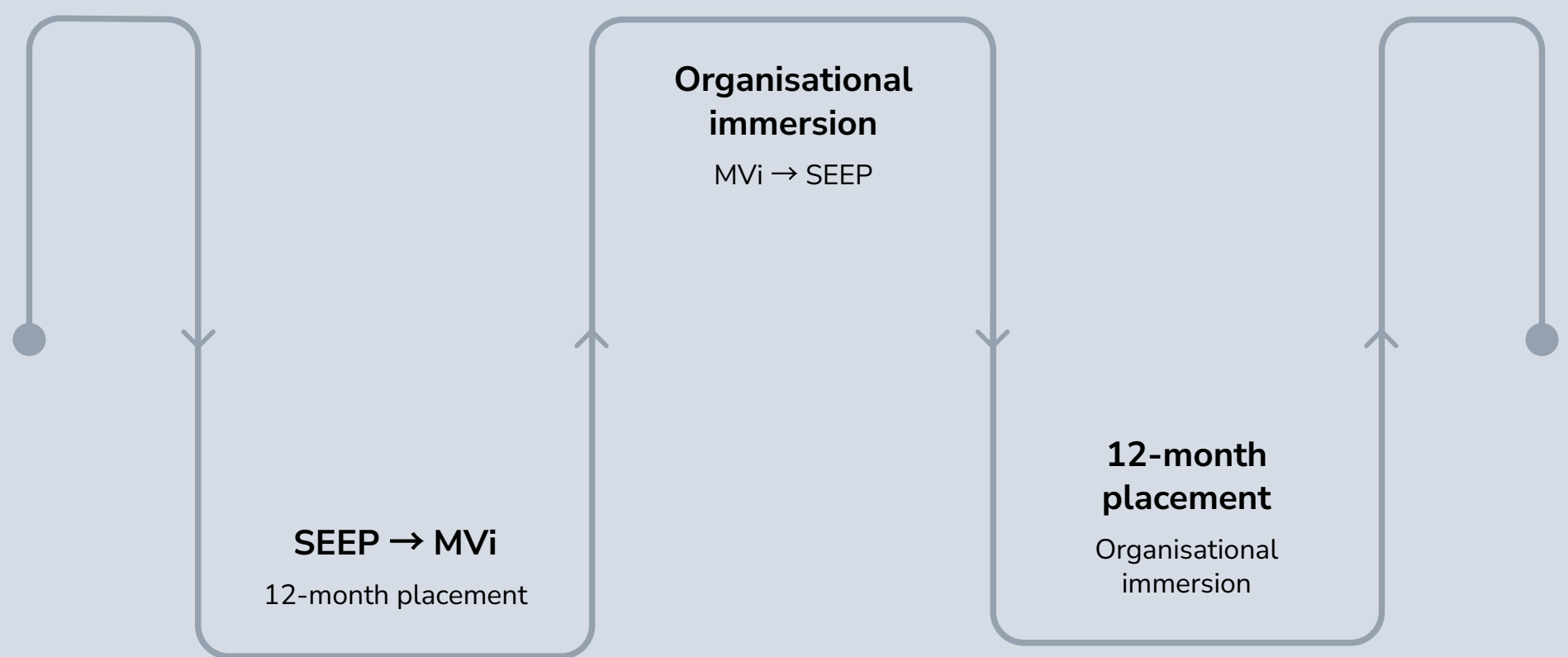




# Our Shared Vision

The MLNP project is built on the principle of **mutual exchange**. Over two rounds of staff exchange, SEEP and MVi will send and receive young professionals to work within each other's organizations for 12 months.

This exchange is designed to be a **two-way street of learning**:







## A Two-Way Street of Learning

### SEEP

SEEP will enhance its capacity in environmental conservation and alternative livelihoods by adopting best practices from Cambodia.

### MVi

MVi will strengthen its organizational capacity and introduce green micro-business models to indigenous communities in Stung Treng province, drawing on SEEP's extensive experience in climate resilience and livelihood adaptation.





## Key Objectives for SEEP

Through this partnership, SEEP aims to achieve the following institutional milestones:

1

### **Strategic Integration**

We will formally incorporate "Environment and Climate Change" as a distinct thematic area within SEEP's strategic plan and organizational framework.

2

### **Resource Development**

Development of two comprehensive manuals focused on environmental conservation strategies and alternative livelihoods, finalized with insights from MVi's practices.



# Key Objectives for SEEP (continued)

1

## Staff Capacity Building

Training for **60 SEEP staff members** (20 in Round 1, 40 in Round 2) to lead new environmental initiatives.

2

## Community Impact

Launching community-led conservation initiatives and awareness sessions for natural resource-dependent groups in Bangladesh.



### Staff Capacity

Train 60 SEEP staff across two rounds



### Round 1

Train 20 staff to pilot initiatives



### Round 2

Train 40 staff for scale-up



### Community Impact

Launch community-led conservation



### Awareness Sessions

Target natural resource-dependent groups

# The Exchange Model

The project will facilitate professional growth through deep immersion.



## Participants

4 participants per round will travel abroad to work directly with the partner organization.



## Commitment

Participants will spend 12 months abroad followed by a 2-month follow-up period to reintegrate and share their new skills with their home organization.



## Support

All participants will receive full employment contracts, monthly stipends, accommodation, and insurance coverage during their exchange.
